

Morgan Dressage Association Schooling Show Awards of Excellence New for 2020

The Morgan Dressage Association is proud to recognize its member's accomplishments and offers yearend awards to members who compete in all individual levels of dressage, musical freestyle, and paradressage at schooling shows. All award-winning competitors will received a gold stamped certificate of achievement and will be listed on the MDA website and in the MDA newsletter. Rules, regulations and requirements of the awards are listed below. Good luck!

INDIVIDUAL LEVEL AWARDS, MUSICAL FREESTYLE AWARDS AND PARA-DRESSAGE SCHOOLING SHOW AWARDS

The Individual, Freestyle, and Para MDA Schooling show Awards are all subject to the following rules and requirements:

- FOR 2020 ONLY Two separate scores earned from two different judges (normally three scores from three judges)
- Judges should be at least USDF L graduates (ww.usdf.org/about/contact/graduates.asp) if not USEF licensed 'r', 'R' or 'S' judges
- These two scores may come from two open competitions, or one open and one breed restricted competition. Not more than one score from a breed restricted competition will be accepted.
- At least one of the scores submitted must be from the highest test of the level.
- The two scores will be averaged to calculate the final score.
- A horse and rider combination can be awarded a first place at the same level up to two times total in the MDA Schooling Show Awards of Excellence program at Introductory through Fourth Level.
 FEI level and Para-Equestrian Schooling Show Awards may be won by the same horse/rider at the same level indefinitely.
- All riders, handlers and owners must be competing with AMHA registered Morgan horses.
- The MDA competition year is November 1st through October 31st.

INDIVIDUAL LEVEL SCHOOLING SHOW AWARDS (INTRODUCTORY THROUGH GRAND PRIX)

The top five horse and riders at each level will receive a certificate honoring their achievement. Awards will be given in the Open division which is awarded to the highest scoring horse, and to Adult Amateur and Junior/Young Riders (a competitor is a Junior/Young Rider until the end of the calendar year in which he or she reaches age 21). As well as being subject to the MDA Schooling Show Award Rules and Regulations, the following rules apply to Individual Schooling Show Awards applicants:

- The Adult Amateur or Junior/Young Rider must be a current MDA member.
- The Open division owner or rider (not both) must be a current MDA member.
- The average of the scores submitted must meet or exceed 60% for Introductory through Fourth level.

• The average of the scores submitted must meet or exceed 55% for FEI level competitors.

<u>MUSICAL FREESTYLE SCHOOLING SHOW AWARDS</u> (THREE DIVISIONS: FIRST/SECOND, THIRD/FOURTH AND FEI)

The top five horse and riders at each level will receive a certificate honoring their achievement. As well as being subject to the MDA Schooling Show Awards Rules and Regulations, the following rules apply to Musical Freestyle Schooling Show Award applicants:

- Competitors may mix levels within a single division, i.e. one score could be from First Level and a second score from Second Level to qualify for the First and Second Level divisions. However, competitors may not mix scores from levels outside that division (i.e. they may not use a score from Second Level and a score from Third Level to qualify for either the First/Second Level division or the Third/Fourth Level division.
- The owner or rider (not both) of the horse must be a current MDA member.
- The average of the scores submitted must meet or exceed 60% for First through Fourth level.
- The average of the scores submitted must meet or exceed 55% for FEI level competitors.

PARA-DRESSAGE SCHOOLING SHOW AWARDS (ONE DIVISION INCLUDING GRADES 1-4)

The top five horses and riders will receive a certificate honoring their achievement. As well as being subject to the MDA Schooling Show Award Rules and Regulations, the following rules apply to Para-Dressage Schooling Show Awards applicants:

- The owner or rider (not both) of the horse must be a current MDA member.
- Only one score submitted can be an Introductory test
- The average of the scores submitted must meet or exceed 55%

TO APPLY FOR SCHOOLING SHOW AWARDS

- 1. Fill out the MDA Schooling Show Award of Excellence application <u>completely AND legibly</u> for <u>each</u> division submitted (make a copy of the form if more than two divisions/levels are entered; e.g. if you are entering for Individual and Musical Freestyle, a *separate application must be submitted for each division*).
- 2. Submit copies/photos of test cover sheets for all your tests listed with each application. Circle or highlight the scores you wish to enter for the MDA Schooling Show Awards. It is your responsibility to have the schooling show organizers fill out the test cover sheet for you complete with your name, your horse's name, judges name and signature, date, show name and final score.
- 3. Send both (the application AND the copies/photos of test cover sheets) to the address on the application by November 1st of the competition year.

*Remember, All eligible horses **MUST** be registered with the AMHA. To qualify for a Schooling Show Award of Excellence the owner **OR** the rider/handler (as described above) **MUST** be a current member of the Morgan Dressage Association at the time the entry is submitted. Additionally, to participate in the Junior/Young Rider division or for the Adult Amateur Schooling Show Award, the rider **MUST** be an MDA member. If you have any question as to your membership status, refer to the on-line member directory or contact Karin Weight at kweight84601@yahoo.com. Entries from non-members will not be eligible and will be returned.

To be considered for the Schooling Show Award, all entries **MUST be postmarked or received electronically** by November 1st of the competition year (forms can be sent at any time during the year). - ✓ Application is post marked or emailed no later than November 1st of the competition year.
